As a mediator, Mr. Berman will be seeking to draw out the underlying reasons behind their positions in an effort to have those interests and their reasoning be better understood, to diffuse the conflict, and to attempt to enter into a consensus-building, problem-solving dialogue by working with the common interests that they and their constituents may share.
